

Edge of Hell 2021 Covid-19 Plan

All activities take place outside Lewiston city limits. Therefore, City of Lewiston ordinances and regulations are not applicable.

The course will be set up the day before the run and torn down after the run.

If Idaho (or Nez Perce County, whichever is more restrictive) is in Stage 1 or 2, runners will start at a time of their choosing anytime between 8:30am and 10:30am. Trophies will be delivered or mailed to over-all winners the week after the race. Ribbons will be mailed to age-group winners (decade categories) the week after the race. Masks will be encouraged when not participating in the run.

If Idaho (or Nez Perce County, whichever is more restrictive) is in Stage 3, the run will be started in waves of 5-10 runners with faster runners encouraged to start in earlier waves to reduce passing on the trail. Masks will be encouraged when not participating in the run. Awards will be distributed at the event.

If Idaho (or Nez Perce County, whichever is more restrictive) is in Stage 4, the run will be held as usual with a mass start. Runners who choose not to participate in a mass start may start late. Timing will be “chip” rather than “gun.” Masks will be encouraged when not participating in the run. Awards will be distributed at the event.

Snacks will be packaged in advance to reduce contact of potentially high-contact items. Volunteers will fill cups to reduce contact on fluid dispensers.

The run will be timed by the Seaport Striders, visually inspecting bibs to eliminate contact between timers and participants.
